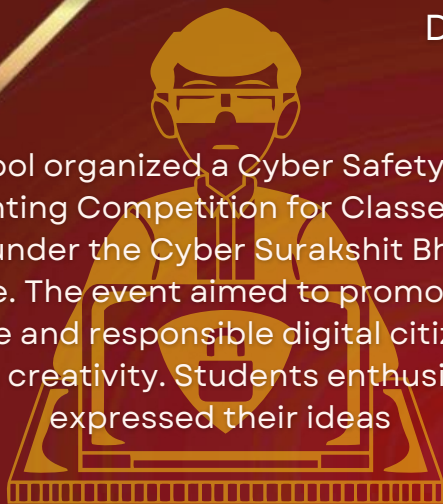

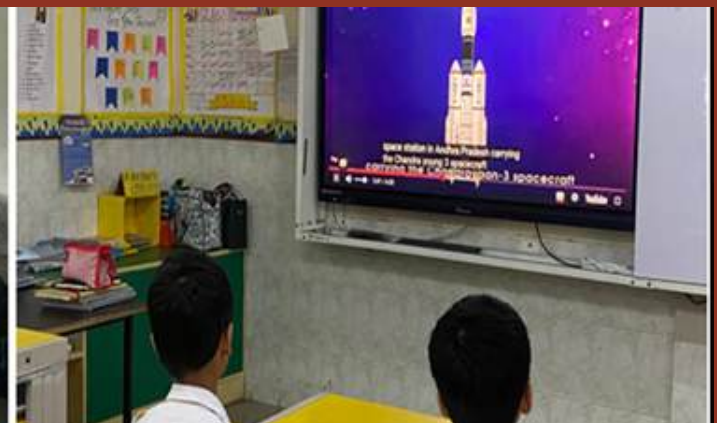
### Workshop on Hydroponics (23/08/2025)

### Empowering Educators, Enriching Classrooms (Aug 22-23)

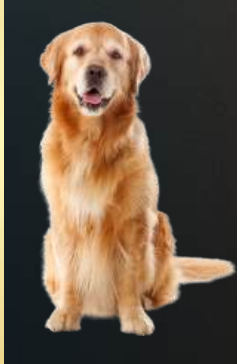

### Doggies - language of Dogs Session (26/08/2025)

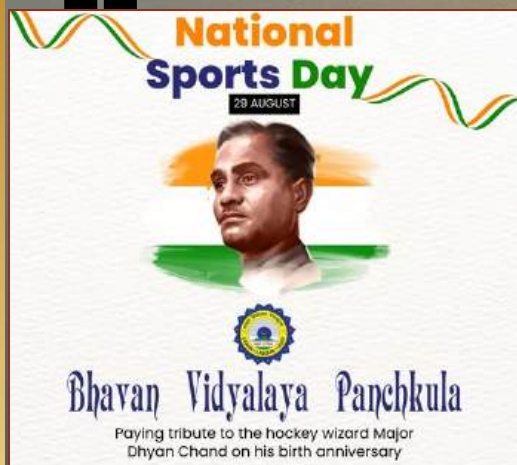

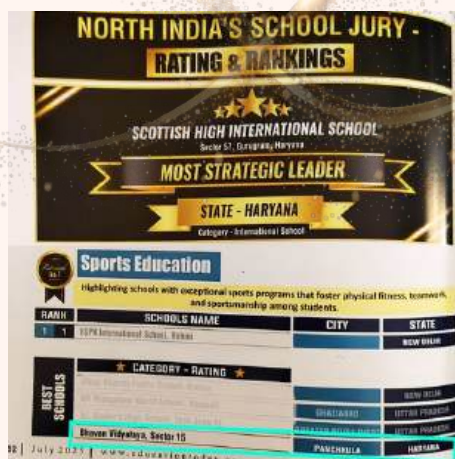
