Bhavanites celebrate the Glow of Lohri (13.01.2025)



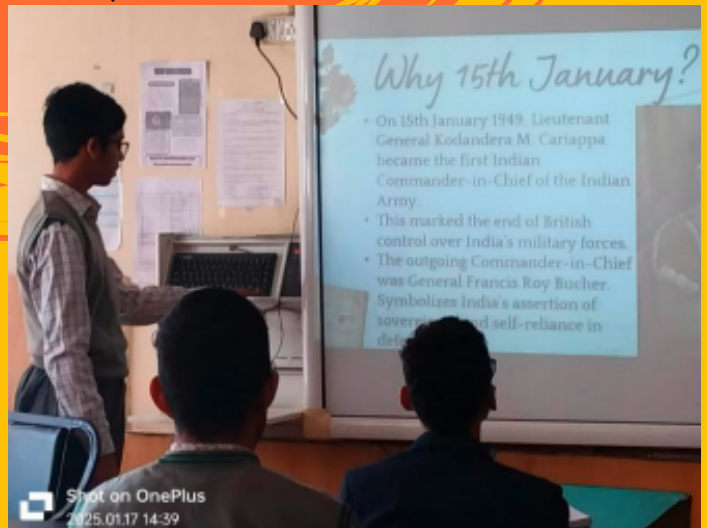

Tejas Khatkar: Mastering the Greens, Conquering the Castle Strokes!



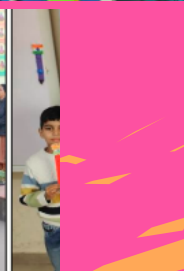

Empowering Leadership, Inspiring Nation Building: Ms. Gulshan Kaur's Achievement



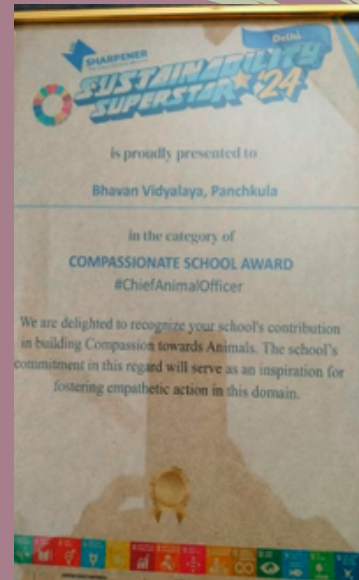

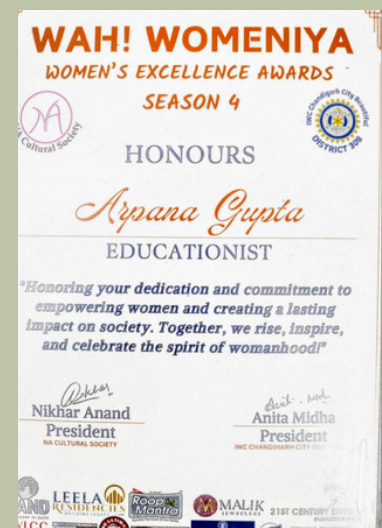

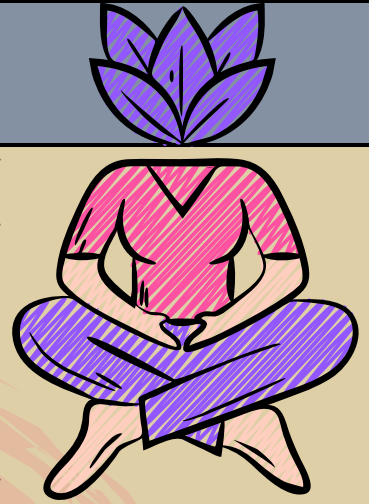


MARCH :MONTH OF FINAL STRIDES AND REFLECTIONS

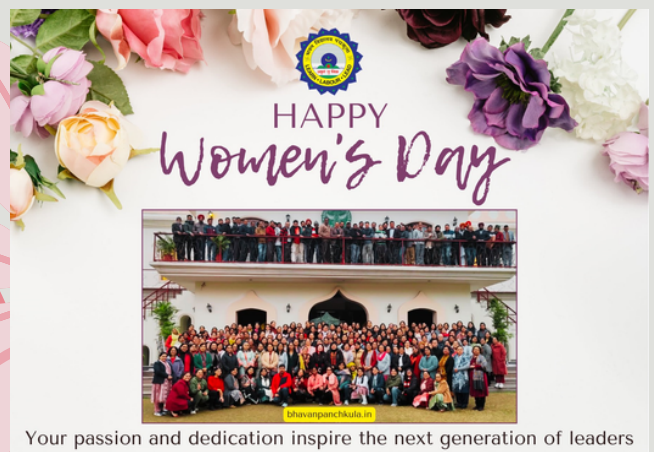
Ms. Arpana Gupta bags special recognition

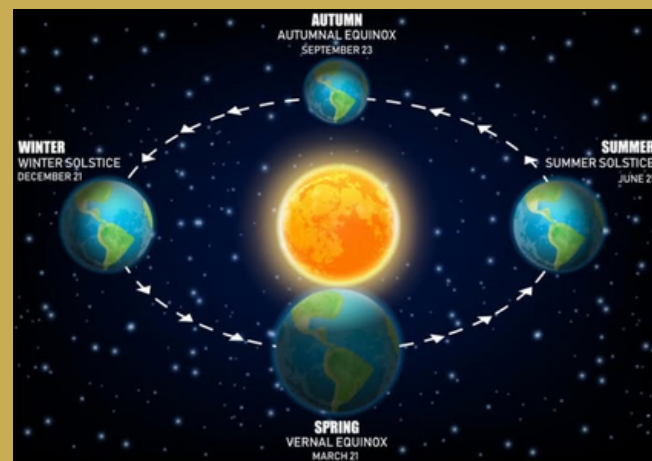
